Sarah Williams, Payne Hicks Beach

Sarah specialises in international and domestic surrogacy matters and cases involving children conceived following artificial insemination. Sarah also has extensive experience in complex children law matters, often with an international dimension, as well a practice concerning vulnerable adults. Sarah spent the first decade of her career as a practising Barrister representing parents, children, Guardians, Local Authorities and the Official Solicitor. Sarah is a member of the American Bar Association, Association of Lawyers for Children, International Bar Association and the Franco-British Lawyers Society.



Professor Susan Golombok

Professor Susan Golombok, former Director of the University of Cambridge Centre for Family Research, has pioneered research on families with lesbian mothers, gay fathers, transgender parents, single parents by choice, and families created by assisted reproductive technologies including IVF, sperm donation, egg donation and surrogacy. Her research has challenged commonly held assumptions about these families and contributed to policy and legislation on assisted reproduction and the family nationally and internationally. Her most recent book is We Are Family: What Really Matters for Parents and Children.



Delphine Eskenazi, Libra Avocats

Delphine Eskenazi is the founding partner of the lawfirm "Libra Avocats". She is currently specialized in international family law, in order to advise private clients on their complex family issues.
